The Responsibilities of the School

At West Witney we will:

- Provide your child with a high standard of education, implemented in accordance with national guidelines, within a broad and balanced curriculum.
- Ensure that our learning environment is stimulating and challenging.
- Celebrate your child's academic and personal achievements.
- Provide the education needed to enable your child to achieve their full potential.
- Care for your child's safety and nurture their well-being by observation and listening to them.
- Teach your child to develop positive attitudes to one another, regardless of gender, race, culture, belief, values, age and need.
- Encourage your child to become an active member within our community and help them to see that they can have an impact on the world around them.
- Regularly meet with you to communicate the progress of your child, celebrating their strengths and explaining how we can support and scaffold them in their areas for development.
- Provide information to you about our school, including relevant policies, meetings, workshops, activities, newsletters and open days.
- Be very happy to welcome you if you would like to contribute to our school's broader curriculum. We recognise that the community of West Witney holds a wealth of talent, experience, diversity and enthusiasm from which our school could benefit.
- Set achievable homework to extend the curriculum and provide the opportunity for independent learning. Clear information will be provided so that you will be able to help your child if required.

The Responsibilities of the Parents/Carers

- Having chosen West Witney School for your child, accept the school's goals and values, positively supporting the school.
- Ensure that your child attends school punctually every day during term time and not take term time holidays.
- Notify the school in the event of absence.
- Support the school's policies and guidelines on learning, behaviour and uniform, both in school and at home.
- When necessary, support the school in managing your child's behaviour and reinforce expectations at home.
- Attend parent/teacher meetings to discuss your child's progress.
- Keep us informed of where to contact you in case of emergency.
- Promptly inform the school of any concerns or problems that may affect your child's learning, behaviour or happiness at school.
- Support the school by making sure that homework tasks are completed and returned on time. A child who hasn't completed their homework is often an unhappy, worried one!
- Read regularly with your child and foster a love of reading at home. Without this, a love of reading cannot be achieved.
- Use your talents and experiences to enhance your child's learning at home – your child will benefit greatly from what you can show them, discuss with them and teach them.
- Support school in the teaching of safe and secure Internet/mobile phone use at home.
- Respect the staff at West Witney School and always show politeness when speaking to them.
